Key Terms

Impact Report for the Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP)—Demonstrates the extent to which the QEP has affected outcomes related to student learning and/or student success. It is submitted as part of the Fifth-Year Interim Report five years prior to an institution's reaffirmation review.

Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP)—A carefully designed and focused course of action derived from the institution's existing planning and evaluation processes that addresses a well-defined issue directly related to enhancing specific student learning outcomes and/or student success. (Standard 7.2)

Reaffirmation of Accreditation—The process for ensuring that member institutions maintain continuing compliance with SACSCOC policies and with the Principles of Accreditation. An institution's accreditation must be reaffirmed five years after it gains initial accreditation and every ten years thereafter.

Student Learning—Defined broadly as enhancing student knowledge, skills, behaviors, and/or values.
